The WRITER Project

This poster describes an umbrella project which will have many research directions and outputs. Ultimately the aim of this research is to:

- monitor industry trends with regard to Information and Communications Technology (ICT) jobs, job vacancies and skill sets.
- monitor ICT curricula in schools and tertiary institutions.
- inform ICT educators and employers of emerging trends with a view to preparing students for future employment and supplying industry needs.
- compare trends across various regions in New Zealand.
- compare trends in New Zealand with other countries.
- Align course content and develop programmes in line with industry trends.

To achieve the above, a web application with a database back end will be set up on a secure server hosted at Waiariki.

Stage A:

- 1) The development of a front end web application to handle on-line questionnaires. This will be supported by a database, at the back end, that will allow storage and processing of the collected data input by company representatives. This will involve:

- a) research and analysis leading to categorising ICT sector jobs.
 - b) research into the skill sets currently sought for each job category.
 - c) preparation of the questionnaire.
 - d) preparation of the data model.
- 2) Contacting a very large number of companies through various group email lists (approx 50,000).
 - 3) Analysis of data entered on-line by the company representatives to:
 - a) categorise industries.
 - b) determine the number of companies in each category.
 - c) determine the number of existing jobs in each category.
 - d) compare this data across regions within New Zealand.

Stages B and beyond:

Further questionnaires will be prepared and results analysed and published on the web site and at future conferences.

Note:

An accompanying poster **Categorising ICT Sector Jobs** describes research done by the team which will be used in creating the on-line questionnaire to initially populate the WRITER database.
