This was also an opportunity to enhance existing knowledge and skills.

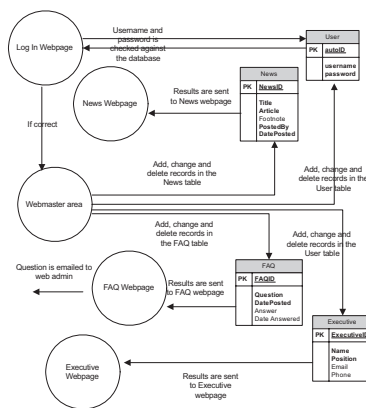
