

## Recognising Excellence in Student Projects

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### **Proposal**

We would like to propose the establishment of an annual publication of student projects. This publication would be reviewed by a panel drawn from NACCQ and published in association with the annual conference. Submissions would be invited from all tertiary institutions in New Zealand and would take the form of a two page paper, in a design science format that provides a concise summary of the project. The review will be designed to enforce a minimum standard but resubmissions will be invited from those who do not initially meet the standard.

### **Process**

The process we envisage is for students under the guidance of their supervisors to submit their papers through the normal NACCQ submission process as a separate category of papers and reviewed by the panel. Potential candidates for best projects awards would be identified by the editorial team and judged at the conference, perhaps by an industry representative.

### **Conclusion**
